## History of Lowry High School

In 1967, a brand new Humboldt County High School was opened with the new name Albert Lowry High School in honor of revered Coach Albert M. Lowry.

A true Nevadan, Mr. Lowry was born in Tollhouse in 1897. He graduated from the University of Nevada in 1925, began teaching Science and coaching three sports in Winnemucca.

Mr. Lowry served the students of Humboldt County as a teacher, coach, principal, assistant superintendent and as director of the Nevada Education Association.

One of Nevada's first sporting legends, Mr. Lowry was instrumental in putting Humboldt County High School on the map. His basketball teams won 11 district or league championships and finished as the 1929 runner-up in the Nevada State Tournament.

As a track coach, he led his teams to Nevada championships in 1928, 1930, and 1936.
Mr. Lowry was also an integral part of introducing six-man football to some of Nevada's smaller schools. In 1941, he was chosen as the state's "Outstanding Coach".

Mr. Lowry served as president of the Nevada Interscholastic Athletic Association (NIAA) for 14 years and was chosen 3 times as a delegate to the National Federation of State High School Athletic Associations.

In 1933, Mr. Lowry was inducted into the NIAA Hall of Fame. He retired from the school district in 1966 and passed away May 5, 1989.

The original Lowry High School building was ready for use in 1967, with the vocational building added in 1983 the science building in 1991, the following improvements were made since then: weight room, new gym, art/social studies building, Jim Billingsley Softball Complex, new track-lighting and landscaping, baseball \& softball announcers booth.

## LOWRY HIGH - TRADITIONS OF PRIDE, DEDICATION \& EXCELLENCE History of Winnemucca

Winnemucca, originally called French Ford, sprouted up from a wagon crossing on the Humboldt River. A trading post and hotel were the first businesses in Winnemucca, the hotel serving miners and prospectors as well as wagon trains that were passing through on their way to California or Oregon.

Two brothers, Louis and Theophile Lay, built a bridge across the Humboldt River. After this, it was not necessary to ford the river and the town was renamed to Centerville. Soon after, the railroad was built so residents looked for a name that fit the town better.
L.C. Pease or C.B.O. Bannon are usually given credit for naming the town. They chose to name the town after Chief Winnemucca, the leader of a local Paiute tribe. Another theory is that a nameless worker for the Central Pacific Railroad wanting to keep peace with the Paiutes suggested naming Winnemucca after the Paiute chief. It is reasonable that all three men chose the name of the town as an agreement was necessary. Winnemucca was an apt name as the mountain and mining district had been named for the Paiute chief since 1863.

Chief Winnemucca came by his name as a boy. When he was young, some prospectors found him in the river wearing just one moccasin. Using the Pauite word "muchcha" for moccasin, they called him "wan-ne-muc-cha." Young Chief Winnemucca liked the sound of the word and took it for his name. Later it came to mean "one moccasin."

## Hall OF FAME

Lowry High School will be sponsoring a Hall of Fame for deserving Winnemucca individuals who attended or taught at Humboldt County High School or Albert M. Lowry High School. 1994 was the inaugural year for this program and we encourage you to think back and nominate a deserving individual for this prestigious award. Nominees not selected this year will be placed in an active file for future years.

## Purpose:

The purpose of the Hall of Fame is to honor and recognize outstanding individuals who have had a significant and lasting impact on the lives of people through their involvement as student and/or athlete or educator at our local high school. These individuals must have excelled in high school and continued to exemplify high standards in their adult lives to be eligible for this award.

## Nomination procedures:

1. Candidates can be nominated by any person.
2. The "selection committee" will be composed of four representatives to serve a maximum four year term. The athletic administrator will select those individuals and the names of the individuals will be confidential.

## Nomination Deadline:

All nominations must be received in the Lowry High School office no later than Oct 15 of each year. All nominations will remain in an active file for a three year period.

## Awards:

Recipients will have their name placed on a Hall of Fame plaque at Lowry High School and receive a lifetime pass to all Lowry High athletic events.

## General Criteria:

Nominees must exemplify the highest standards of sportsmanship, ethical conduct, moral character and carry the endorsement of their respective high school. An applicant must meet the following qualifications:

1. Athletes - will be eligible for nominations ten years after high school graduation.
2. Teachers, Coaches, Administrators, and Contributors will be eligible after their service to Humboldt County School District has ended.

To further explain, athletes would be former student participants who are being nominated for their achievements in interscholastic athletics. Students and educators would be considered on the merits of their high school achievements only. A contributor would be an individual who has made a contribution to Winnemucca education in some capacity other than those previously mentioned, including such areas as sports medicine, sports media, school participation, etc.

## Jace Billingsley, 2012 graduate of Albert M. Lowry High School



While at Eastern Oregon University Jace has been awarded many team, school, conference and national honors. Jace has been named EOU "Offensive Player of the Week" and "Hard Hat" numerous times as a receiver, running back and return specialist. The Frontier Conference has named \#7 special teams and offensive player of the week several times. Jace has also been named "National Offensive Player of the Week" by the NAIA.

In his four years at EOU Jace as earned First Team All-Conference as a running back, receiver and kick off returner. In all Jace has been named six times to All-Conference teams as well as three Frontier Conference Academic All-Conference teams. Jace is a two time AFCA- NAIA All-American as a receiver earning those honors in 2013 and 2015.

EOU recognized Jace as Eastern Oregon University "Male Student Athlete" in 2015 and was the recipient of the Ragsdale Scholarship Award which recognizes athletic participation, academic excellence and character attributes such as integrity, sportsmanship, servant leadership, respect and responsibility.

This is what was read at the EOU football senior day, Jace's last football game as a Mountie.
Jace Billingsley, a two year captain will undoubtedly go down as one of the best Mountaineers in program history. Over the course of his career, this Winnemucca, Nevada, native registered 1,784 rushing yards, 2,596 receiving yards on 249 catches, 1,485 kickoff return yards, 258 points, 5,996 all-purpose yards and 42 touchdowns. He is the all-time leader in several statistical categories, including receiving yards, touchdowns, receptions, points, and also holds the longest kickoff return for a touchdown, 100 yards. Jace is the EOU single season record holder for receptions, 69 and pionts,102. Coach Camp and his staff had this to stay about Jace: "The impact that Jace has had on the Mountaineer football program during his four years at EOU cannot be overstated. His unrelenting determination and commitment to being the best at whatever he does has allowed us all to witness one of the most prolific careers in the history of Eastern Oregon University athletics. As he walks away from his unprecedented run as a Mountie, Jace does so as the most decorated skill player in the history of Mountaineer football. Although we are saddened to see his days on the football field in EOU blue and gold come to an end, all of us in the Mountaineer family would sincerely like to thank \#7 for the memories and unforgettable moments that he has given us all."

"I'm here to tell you one thing, there's not a better player in the country than Jace Billingsley. He is the best player that has ever played at Eastern Oregon. There is no doubt about it. He has meant everything to our program."

Jace has a 3.76 GPA while studying to be a history teacher and a coach.

2013 Lowry High School Graduated Michael Billingsley recently entered his second year at the United States Air Force Academy. Michael attended USAFA Prep School in the summer of 2013 and entered the Air Force Academy in Colorado Springs, Colorado in the summer of 2014. While wrestling at the Prep school , Michael earned All American Honors at the NWC Nationals finishing fourth at 165 Lbs. As a freshman, Michael earned a varsity letter for the Falcons with a record of 10-8.
During his time at Lowry High School Michael was an All-State, All league football player and a four time Nevada State Wrestling Champion. He was also a pole vaulter during the spring.
Academically Michael graduated with honors and 3.9 G.P.A. He was active in Honor Society and a Block W. Officer. Michael will earn a degree in Business Management along with becoming an Air Force Pilot and Officer.

## NIAA ALCOHOL, TOBACCO AND OTHER DRUG POSSESSION, USE, ABUSE and PENALTIES POLICY

Participation in NIAA sanctioned sports is a privilege and responsibility which requires all participants to adhere to athletic training rules imposed by the school district and member or affiliate school the student attends and represents. Adherence to training rules ensures that all studentathletes are in top physical condition, minimizes potential for injury, and further ensures that all member and affiliate school athletic teams are appropriately represented by their student-athletes. Therefore, the possession or use of any controlled substance, alcohol or tobacco products by a student athlete, whether it occurs on or off of school property, is prohibited and shall result in the penalties set forth herein.

This regulation shall begin once our son/daughter begins participation as a student athlete in high school athletics. This policy remains in effect for every calendar school year during the course of his/her high school career and when he/she is directly involved in a school activity occurring at any time (summer leagues / camps, etc.). This policy remains in effect regardless of whether our son/daughter is currently participating on a high school athletic team.
a. Definitions - The following terms or phrases shall have the meaning ascribed to them for purposes of interpreting this Policy.

1. Competitive Week - means a seven (7) day period of time beginning with the first scheduled competition after a violation occurs in which a student athlete is participating as a member of an athletic team for a member or affiliate school, and in which that team is officially competing in NIAA sanctioned competition.
2. Controlled Substance - includes any mind altering substance or beverage set forth in Schedule I-V of the list of Controlled Substances as identified by the office of the Drug Enforcement Administration or as set forth in 21 U.S.C. $\$ 812$.
3. Period of Suspension - means a student athlete is prohibited from appearing in any NIAA sanctioned sport or event as a member of an athletic team or in individual competition. A suspension from athletic competition begins with the first scheduled competition after a violation occurs. A student athlete who is suspended under this regulation who does not serve the entire period of suspension during the sport season in which suspension occurs shall serve any remaining period of suspension during the next sport season in which the student athlete appears on a NIAA roster. A violation of this regulation that occurs during a time when a student athlete does not appear on a NIAA roster shall be implemented at the commencement of the next sport season in which the student athlete participates. Attendance in a summer school class shall not apply toward satisfying any period of suspension.
4. Possession means a student / athlete who is in actual physical control of alcohol, tobacco or a controlled substance.
b. Possession or Use of Tobacco/Alcohol/Controlled Substance/Narcotics. Any student athlete determined to be in possession of, or to have used tobacco, including smoking tobacco, chewing tobacco or snuff, an alcoholic beverage (as defined by NRS 202.020 and any relevant local ordinances), controlled substance and/or narcotic (unless prescribed by the student athlete's physician for medical purposes), is in violation of this policy. If after an investigation by the school it is determined that the student athlete is in violation of this regulation the student athlete shall immediately be declared ineligible to compete in any NIAA competition beginning with the first scheduled competition after a violation occurs. Additionally, the student athlete shall be subject to the following discipline:
5. First Violation: a six (6) competitive week suspension from participation in interscholastic competition beginning with the first scheduled competition after the suspension occurs. Four (4) competitive weeks of the suspension of eligibility may be waived if the student successfully completes all components of the appropriate substance abuse intervention program set forth in subparagraphs (d) (1) (A) and (d) (1) (B) below. The student may practice with the team during the period of suspension if approved by the coach and principal.
6. Second Violation: The student shall be suspended from interscholastic competition for a minimum of ninety (90) school days which shall include a minimum of six (6) competitive weeks of competition. The student shall not be allowed to practice with the team, or participate in any out of season activities and must complete the requirements set forth in subparagraphs A and B below, in order to be considered for reinstatement of future athletic eligibility, which shall be determined following the ninety (90) day suspension of athletic eligibility by a group composed of one of the student's parents/legal guardians, the school principal, athletic director, coach and a substance abuse program coordinator.
A. A substance abuse evaluation assessment conducted by a licensed alcohol and drug counselor at the expense of the parent/legal guardian of the student must be completed within ten (10) school days following the suspension and all assessment recommendations must be satisfactorily met before athletic eligibility may be reinstated.
B. The student must successfully participate in all sessions of the appropriate substance abuse interyention program set forth in subparagraphs (d) (1) (a) and (d) (1) (B) below, and successfully complete a minimum of ten (10) tobacco or alcohol/drug related support sessions.
7. Third Violation: The student shall be ineligible to participate in interscholastic athletics for the remainder of the student's high school career.
8. Appeal: A student that serves their third violation and still has more than one year of remaining eligibility can appeal through the NIAA Board of Control. Both the students and his / her parents must attend this meeting of the Board to present their appeal.
c. Cumulative Effect of Suspensions: Multiple suspensions of a student athlete's athletic eligibility based on violations of this Regulation shall be considered as cumulative over the length of each student athlete's high school career, $9^{\text {th }}$ through $12^{\text {th }}$ grade.
d. Substance Abuse Intervention Program: Any student who has been suspended from athletic eligibility for violation of the provisions of this Regulation and whose future athletic eligibility is contingent on successful completion of a Substance Abuse Intervention Program, or whose suspension of athletic eligibility may be reduced through successful participation in a Substance Abuse Intervention Program, shall complete the Substance Abuse Intervention Program developed by the NIAA in conjunction with the State of Nevada, Department of Human Resources Division of Child and Family Services Program available through the Juvenile Justice Programs Office: (775) 684-7294.
9. Successful completion of the Substance Abuse Intervention Program shall require, at a minimum:
A. The completion of a video program specific to the nature of the student athlete's offense, by the student athlete, and his/her parent(s) or legal guardian(s), as demonstrated by the successful completion of an assignment on the content of the video by the student athlete and his/her parent(s) or legal guardian(s).
B. The completion of a minimum of an eight (8) hour assignment selected from a list of ten (10) possible assignments by school personnel. Successful completion shall be determined through a meeting between the student athlete, his/her parent(s) or legal guardian(s), the head coach of the sport in which the student athlete was participating at the time of offense, and the school counselor or dean of students.

All investigations and penalty enforcements will be conducted by the school and / or district with support through the NIAA office.

## PARENT / LEGAL GUARDIAN AND STUDENT ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

The Nevada Interscholastic Activities Association (NIAA) recognizes and understands that parents / guardians take the primary role in instilling values for their students. It is the goal of the NIAA to work cooperatively with parents to provide guidelines and programs that assist student athletes in making positive choices.

IMPORTANT - Please read the following information and acknowledge with your signature below.
We understand that participation in high school athletics is a privilege, not a right, and that underage drinking and drug use is against the law. It is against the law to sell tobacco to people under the age of 18 and usage is against school policy. Substance abuse negatively impacts athletics and academic performance, and research indicates that early onset of alcohol use increases the occurrence of addiction in adulthood by four times. Alcohol and drug use interferes in learning processes, brain development and increases the chance of physical injury while participating in athletic competition. Because of these risks, and in addition to the laws of the State of Nevada, the NIAA requires participants and parents to agree to the following:

1. We have read the NIAA Drug, Alcohol and Tobacco Possession, Use and Abuse Penalties Policy and agree to abide by the Policy as written.
2. We realize that a video and Power Point presentation regarding the Policy is available and we have either seen this presentation or agree to waive the requirement of viewing the presentation.
3. We understand that we are encouraged to notify our school's athletic administrator / director if our son / daughter violates this Policy and / or the laws of the state of Nevada. It would also be acceptable for our child to self-report any violation of this policy to our school's athletic administrator / director.
4. We understand that knowingly providing erroneous information during the course of an investigation of an alleged violation of the policy will result in a one calendar year suspension from all high school athletic activities.
5. We further acknowledge that once our son / daughter begins participation as a student athlete in high school athletics that this policy remains in effect for every calendar school year during the course of their high school career and when he / she is directly involved in a school activity occurring at any time (summer leagues / camps, etc.). This policy remains in effect regardless of whether our son / daughter is currently participating on a high school athletic team.
6. We have also reviewed the following NRS 202.020, Purchase, Consumption or Possession of Alcoholic Beverage by Minor, and understand the laws of Nevada and how they pertain to our family.
7. We understand that although it is not technically against the law to use tobacco in the state of Nevada (NRS 202.2493 and 202.24935 prohibits anyone from supplying a person under the age of 18 with any kind of tobacco product), we realize it is against this policy and general school policy, and that scientific evidence demonstrates it is unhealthy and a detriment to athletic performance.
8. We understand that the use of steroids and other performance enhancing drugs are dangerous, illegal, provide only temporary gains and are a form of cheating other competitors.
